

INFORMATION ON YOUR SEWER PUMP

PLEASE READ AND KEEP

General Information:

A low-pressure sewer system serves your home. The green tank in your yard collects the water and sewage from your home. This tank has a grinder pump in it. The gray box on your home or post by the green tank is the control box. When the red lights flash and the alarm sounds, please contact the Plant Personnel.

All sinks, drains, toilets, and washing machine drains are to be hooked into the system. **NO**

SUMP PUMPS

You Should Never Put the Following Items into the System:

Strong Chemicals	Flammable Materials
Gasoline	Kerosene
Fuel Oil	Lubricating Oil & Grease
Paint	Drywall Compound

You Should Never Put Everyday Items into the System:

Glass	Plastic Objects
Metal	Diapers, Cloth Rags or Wipes
Seafood Shells	Fish Tank Gravel
Kitty Litter	Sanitary Napkins or Tampons
Ashes	Cooking Oil or Grease
Mop Water	Bones

Power Failure:

In the events of a power interruption, water must be kept at a MINIMUM. Usage must be limited to reserve capacity in the tank. If you are going to run off a generator, **PLEASE** contact the Plant Personnel.

Periods of Disuse:

If your house is going to be unoccupied for more than a month, please notify the Plant Personnel.
