# Memo

Subject: January Monthly Report

Jefferson county staff and I have been data collecting across the town with approximately 62% complete. The last 38% of the data collection encompasses the village, remaining islands, and the inland lakes. The weather has slowed the data collection process. Nevertheless, it is still ongoing with what Jefferson County staff has.

There has been some confusion with Real Property Tax Laws, and some entities, such as the American Legion were notified of renewals when they should not have. Allan will be visiting the Legion to introduce himself and to also explain the confusion.

At the end of December, through the beginning of January, data collection notification letters were sent out without a letter to approximately 50 property owners. This matter was resolved by property owners calling the town clerk and the assessor for clarification.

There are 145 building permits and have been working through the permits to ensure that they are collected and valued for the 2025 roll.

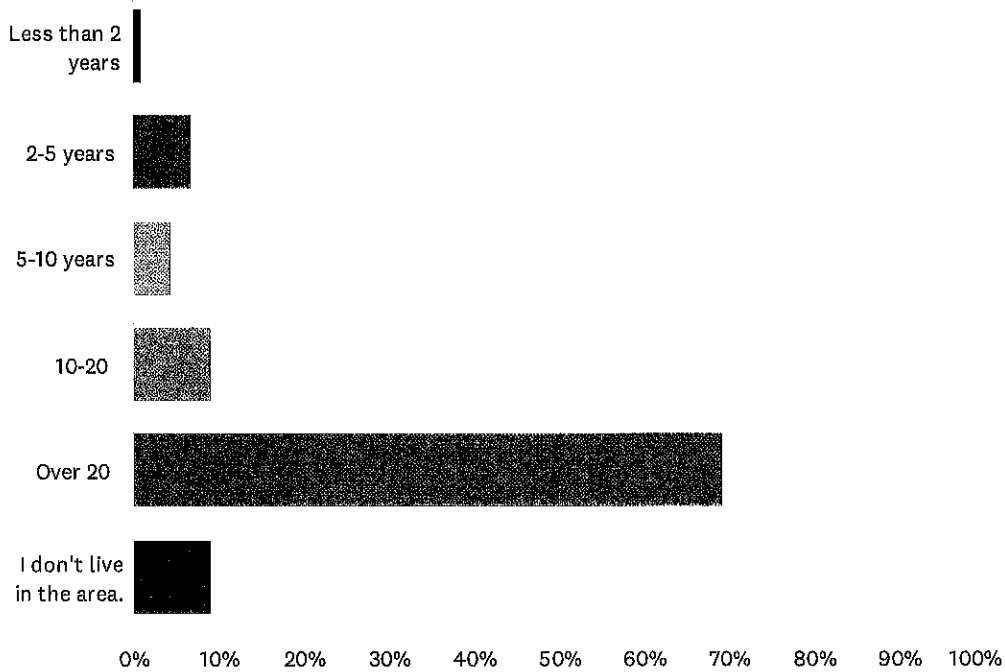

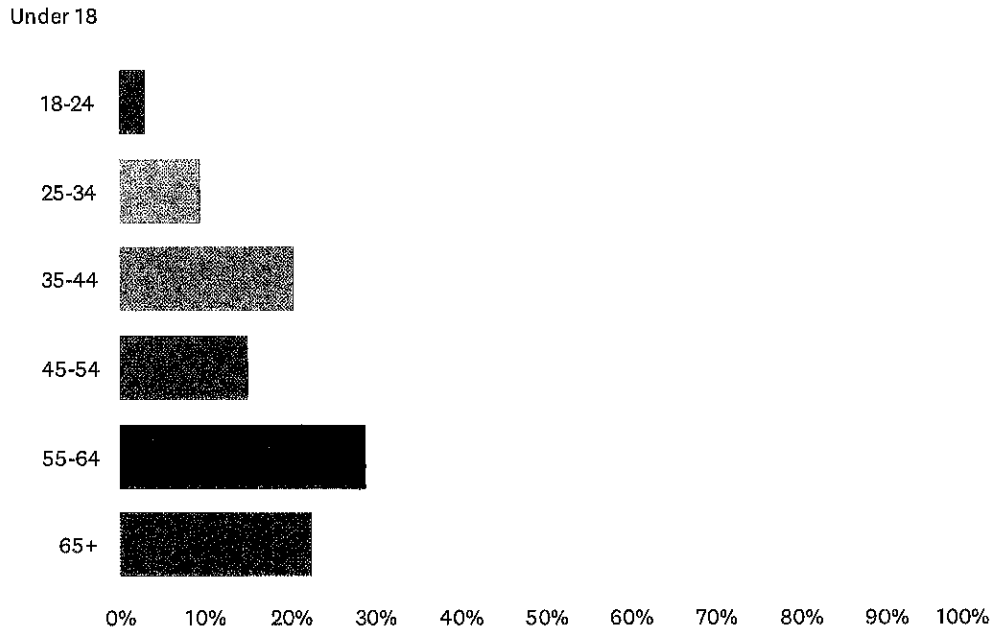

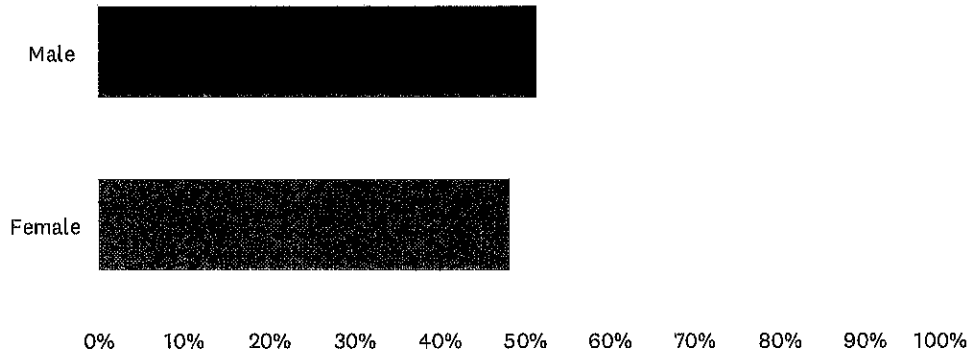

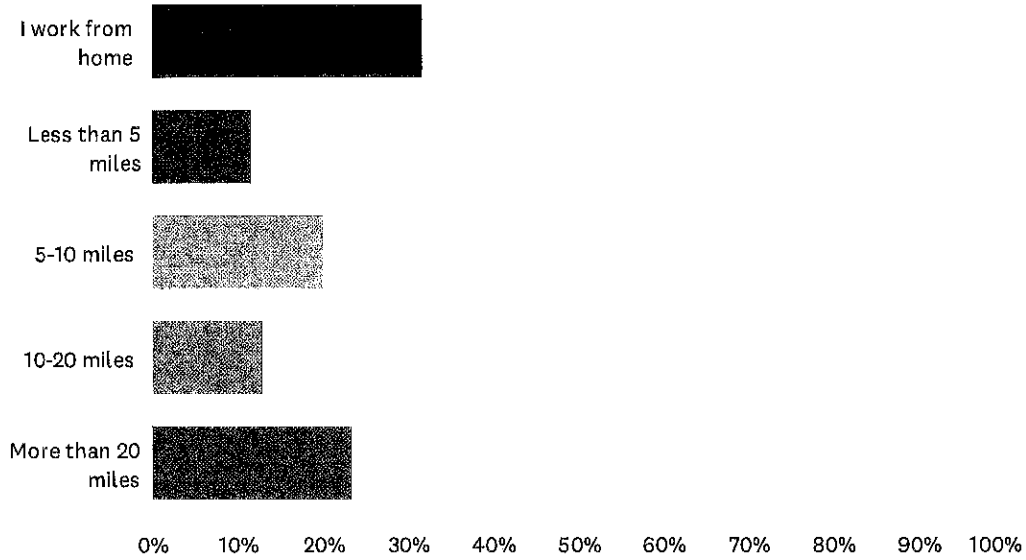

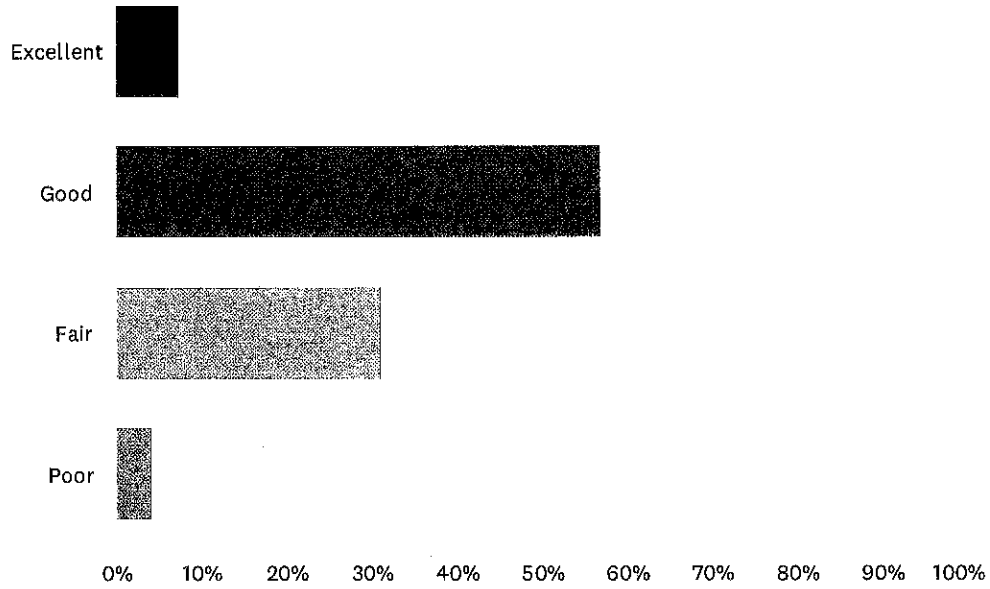

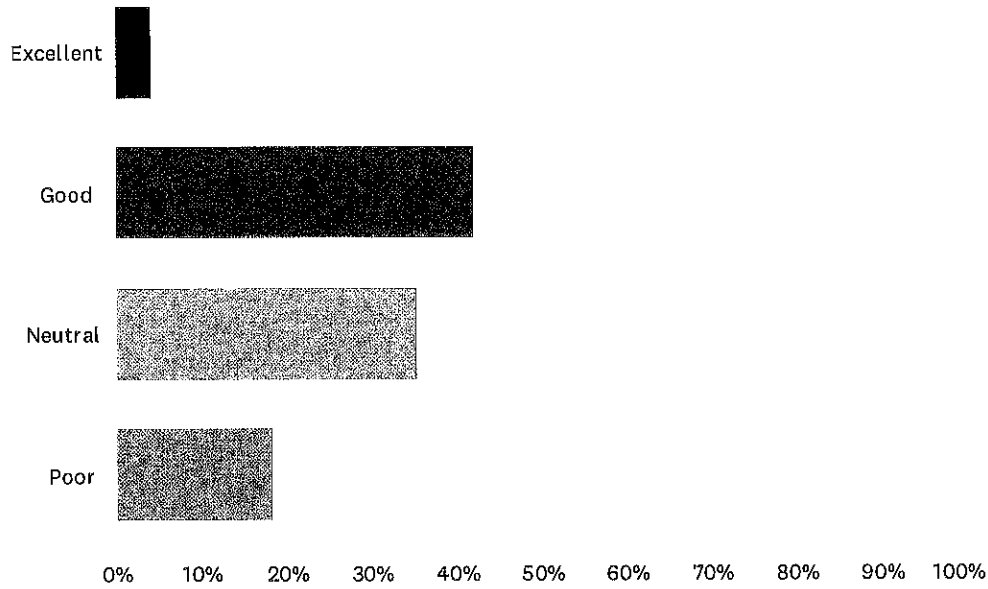

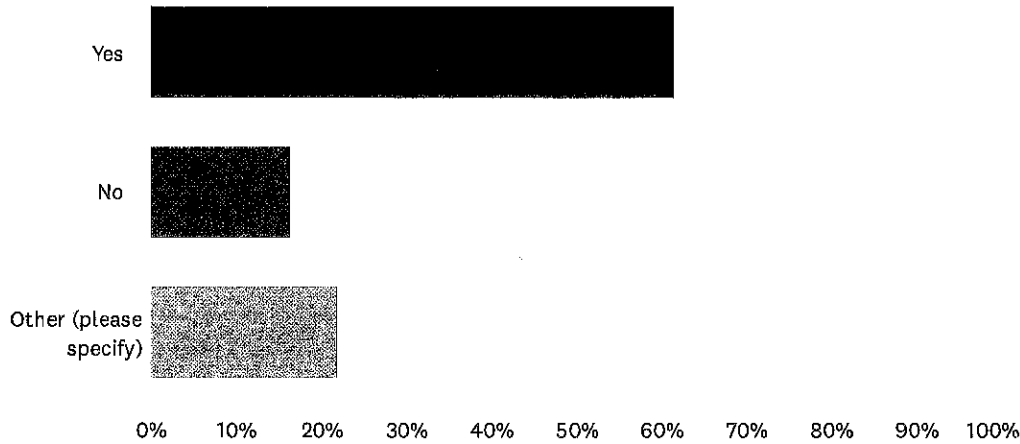
